

TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

RESERVATIONS

A \$300 deposit and completed Reservation Form is required to reserve your space. A second payment of \$600 is due four months prior to departure with the full balance due 60 days prior to departure. If we do not have 9 or 10 people, we will need to impose a surcharge per person—6-7 \$100, 8 \$50. Make checks payable to Copper Canyon Wildflower Tours. Send to Linda J. CANCELLATION BY CLIENTS AND REFUNDS

If you cancel before departure, **cancellation is effective on the date of receipt of your written notification.** Refunds are made according to the following schedule: if cancellation is made 90 or more days before the departure date, the deposits less \$200 is refundable. If cancellation is made between eighty and sixty days before departure date, the deposits less \$300 is refundable. If cancellation is made fewer than sixty days before the departure date, no refund is available. **We recommend that you purchase trip cancellation insurance to protect your investment.** (see note on Insurance)

CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY

Copper Canyon Wildflower Tours reserves the right to cancel any trip prior to departure for any reason whatsoever, including insufficient signup or logistical problems which will impede trip operations. The refund of all payments received shall release Copper Canyon Wildflower Tours from any further liability. Copper Canyon Wildflower Tours is not responsible for non-recoverable expenses incurred by trip members in preparing for a cancelled trip.
